Conditions of use

- 1. You can withdraw your consent at any time by making a written notice to the school
- 2. We will not re-use any photographs or recordings after your child leaves the school
- 3. We will not use the personal details or names of any child or adult in a photographic image on video or on our website, in our school prospectus or in any of our other printed publications without good reason. For example, we may include the full name of a pupil in newsletters to parents if the pupil has won an award.
- 4. If we name a pupil in the text, we will not use a photograph of that child to accompany the article without good reason. (See point 3 above)
- 5. We will not include personal e-mail or postal addresses, or telephone or fax numbers on video, on our website, in our school prospectus or in other printed publications.
- 6. We may include pictures of pupils and teachers that have been drawn by the pupils.
- 7. We may use group or class photographs or footage with very general labels, such as 'a science lesson' or 'making Christmas decorations'.
- 8. We will only use images of pupils who are suitably dressed, to reduce the risk of such images being used inappropriately.

Please note

- i) The press, in certain circumstances are exempt from data protection legislation and may want to include the names and personal details or children and adults in the media.
- ii) Parents, family members and friends taking photographs of children within a school at events such as plays and sports day for their personal, domestic use is also exempt from data protection legislation and therefore do not need to gain consent.
