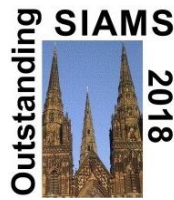
There were lots of fantastic reasons given as to why you would recommend All Saints to other families. These mainly fell into the following categories:

Healthy Schools
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I would like to share with you some of the comments that clearly capture our ethos, vision and values:

Very personal teaching experience in a positive and happy environment.

The school has a very friendly, family environment where children are encouraged to look after each other and be kind to each other.

The school has an excellent atmosphere and they have your child's needs at the forefront of how they operate. Children genuinely leave with fond memories.

The interaction of all children within school improves social skills.

Loving, caring environment in which children can thrive.

Whilst it is good to celebrate all that we are doing well here at All Saints, we recognise that in order to further improve we need to act on those areas that you feel we are performing less well in. Of the 38 questionnaires returned 12 had suggestions for improvement. Of the 12 suggestions made there were no common themes with things being suggested by individual families, if you would like to discuss these suggestions further please do call in for a chat. However, please see some of our future plans below that I feel will address some of the suggestions raised:

After-School Sports Clubs

We have been unsuccessful in engaging an outside provider for after school sports clubs this term due to our geographic location. Mrs Leese continues to provide Multi-Sports on a weekly basis and this is now attended regularly by a group of children and spaces are still available for others to join. We shall be holding further after-school sports clubs in the Spring and Summer terms as both Miss Adams and Mrs Abbotts are keen to run football and dance clubs etc. So please watch this space once they have fully settled into life at All Saints.

Outdoor Learning

We are delighted that Mrs Jones is currently studying for her Forest Schools qualification. This is an intensive 1 year course which will be complete by September 2020. It is our intention to then include Forest Schools in the weekly curriculum of all of our children. Over the coming academic year we would like to develop our outdoor learning space further. If anyone has any contacts or knows of any companies that provide match funding for such a project please do get in touch!

All of our class teachers are regularly updating the school website with information about what your children are doing in class each week. There are also pages that will inform you about our long term curriculum intentions, the topics planned for later in the year and more detailed information about the topics being covered now.
