Prepare a short presentation that you can present to the rest of the class about a place that you have visited. You can use photographs and illustrations to help you if you want to.

Make your own travel brochure. Make a booklet to encourage someone to visit a particular country or continent. You could include flags, maps, facts and pictures in your booklet.
