

What can archaeology tell us about invaders?



Our Topic learning questions this term is, 'What can archaeology tell us about invaders?' This topic is all about the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. I have outlined different homework activities to be completed over the half term.

Please encourage your child to choose one to complete each week (some may take longer than a week to complete); homework should be given in on a Friday.

Children are expected to complete at least four pieces of topic homework over the half term, Possible homework activities will be placed in their homework folders alongside their maths homework, (which they should continue to hand in on a Thursday).

Children should also read to an adult and practice their times tables (using TT Rock Stars) for 10 to 15 minutes each night to support with this, a home reading question is stuck into your child's reading diary following their weekly guided reading lesson.
