
#### PTFA Newsletter Autumn Term 2023 / 2024

# **PTFA Fundraising**

There are a couple of ways you can help the PTFA raise money without having to do too much!

<u>Name Labels</u> – Mrs Bradley has already requested that all uniform items are named. Sticky name labels can be purchased online from a variety of companies. <u>www.stikins.co.uk</u> offer 30% commission to All Saints on all orders. Just remember to enter the code 427 at checkout. Commission is received annually, so it doesn't matter when Stikins are purchased.

### **Employer Match Funding**

We are lucky enough to have at least one of our parents who works for a company that offers Match Funding as part of their employment. Lots of companies pledge to match a sum of money relating to the amount raised or donated to charity by their employees. As All Saints PTFA is a registered charity, this can be worth a considerable amount. Please do check if your employer offers a similar scheme as for a few hours involvement with the PTFA you could really boost fund raising efforts.

## Easy Fundraising App

We are registered with easyfundraising.org.uk who partners with over 7,000 brands who will donate a part of what you spend to a cause of your choice. You can set up an account online or download the app and set up a donation reminder that activates each time you visit a website. The cost of the donation is covered by the brand so you won't incur any extra costs. It's so simple to use and is such an easy way to fundraise. So far, All Saints have received nearly £1,600 just from our supporters activating the donation reminder while doing their online shopping.

### **Pre-loved School Uniform**

If you have any uniform from previous years that you no longer need, please consider donating to the PTFA so we can get our uniform shop up and running as soon as possible.
