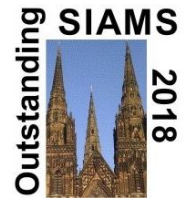

Dear Parents

Please find attached your tickets for this year's performance of Lights Camel Action. As in previous years, the tickets are free of charge. 1. We will be holding a whole school rehearsal at the village hall all morning.
2. If your child will be attending Breakfast Club, please drop them off at the village hall anytime between 8am and 8.45am.
3. Please drop your child (including Busy Bees) off at the village hall between 8.45am and 9.00am. They do not need to bring anything with them – other than a lunchbox if they do not have a school lunch.
4. We will rehearse throughout the morning and then walk back to school in time for lunch at midday.
5. Please collect your child from school as usual at 3.30pm. If you will be needing after school care in Kingfisher club, please let us know as soon as possible.
6. Children will then need to arrive at the Village Hall at 5.30pm in order to get ready for the performance.
7. Parents can buy raffle tickets and enjoy a winter warmer in the main hall as the Village Hall committee will be running a bar between 5.30pm and 6.00pm.
8. At 6.00pm the children will perform 'Lights Camel Action!'
9. We would anticipate that the performance will last approximately 45 minutes.
