Titanic picture - Draw or paint your own picture of the Titanic.

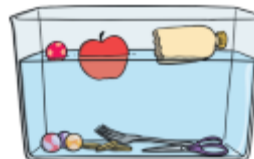


Think of your own piece of home learning about our topics this half term.
