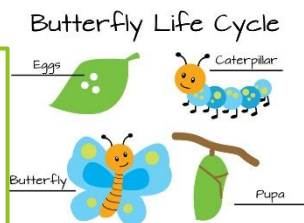

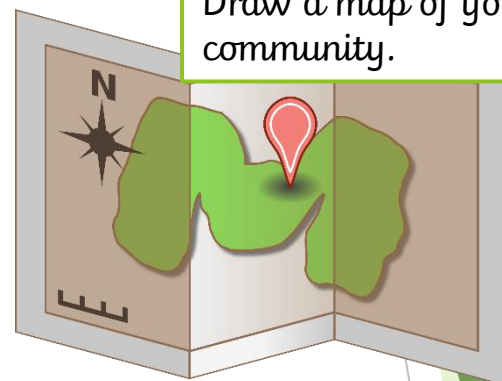
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Watch the video below and create a diagram of the life cycle of your favourite animal.
