

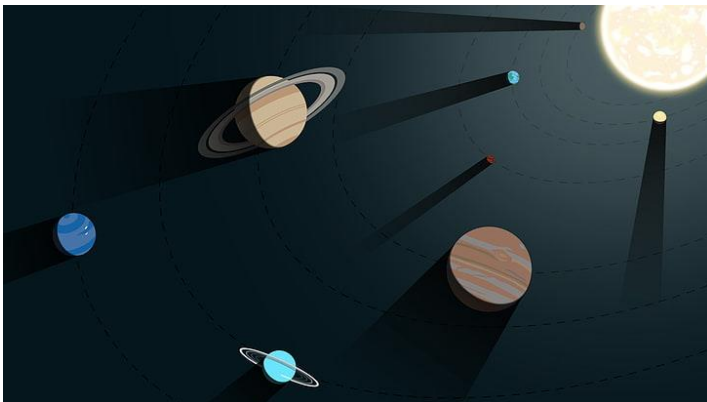
Far, Far Away

Create a wanted poster for your favourite toy. Try to use expanded noun phrases in your description.

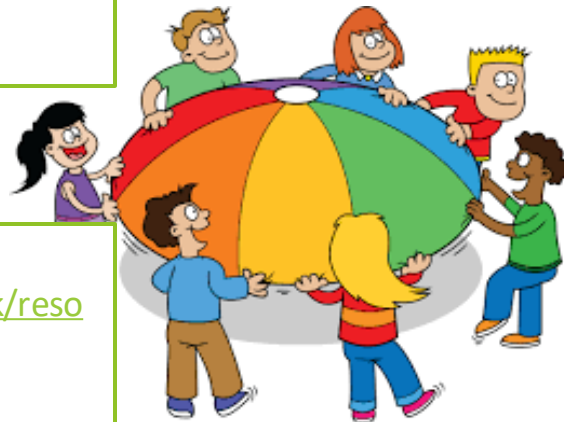


Write instructions on how to play your favourite party game for an alien – remember, they've never played this game before so your instructions must be clear.
