Geography – Land Use Around Me

Task: Draw or list three different types of land use you can see in your local area and label each as human or natural.

You may wish to present this as a map of your local area.

Design & Technology – Levers & Linkages

Task: Find a book, card, or object that moves and describe or draw how it pushes, pulls, or lifts. What materials is it used from? Draw a detailed and labelled diagram of the item.

Science – Light & Shadows

Task: Children look at a shadow at **two different times of the day** (e.g. morning and afternoon OR indoors with a light on/off).

Draw or describe the shadow explaining how it changed.



History – Ancient Civilisations Research

Task: Research either the **Shang Dynasty** and write down where it was, when it existed, one achievement, and one interesting fact.

RE – Learning in a Mosque

Task: Choose one feature of a mosque and explain what it is used for and what it shows about Muslim beliefs.

Computing – Sequencing Sounds

Task: Write or draw three everyday sounds in the order you hear them and number them from first to last.

Explain what makes these sounds (for example: The washing machine makes a tune to let us know that the cycle has ended).
