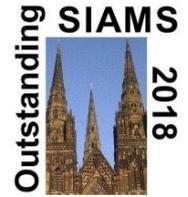

Dear Parents,

As you know we didn't hold our annual Fun Run in October, this is because I wanted to move the event to later in the year (when it is hopefully a bit warmer and dryer) and with an exciting change...

This year the event will take place on the afternoon of **Thursday 19th March from 2.30pm** and will be a **COLOUR FUN RUN**. You are all invited to join us in school and run with your child, as powdered paint is thrown creating an extra layer of fun. A course will be set out on the field and everyone will have the opportunity to complete as many laps of the course as they feel able to in 15 minutes.
