Dear Parents,

Hot Weather

I am writing to inform you that, despite the forecast high temperatures this week, the school will remain open as normal.

We are continuing to follow guidance from the Department for Education. Due to our small cohort, we are in a strong position to minimise movement around the school, which helps to reduce the build-up of heat within classrooms and maintain a more comfortable environment for the children.

To further support this, we have made some adjustments to the timetable for tomorrow and Thursday. These changes will allow for more outdoor activities during the cooler parts of the morning, helping children to remain comfortable while still enjoying their learning.

We have also taken precautions around playtimes. In line with current guidance, we will not be using playground equipment, including footballs, and will be keeping physical and high-energy activities to a minimum. Similarly, PE lessons with Time4Sport on Thursday will be adapted so that children take part in calmer, low-intensity activities.

Rowan Class children due to take part in the football tournament at Eccleshall Eagles on Friday, I am in contact with the organisers of the event and will keep parents updated with any information I receive.

Please be reassured that the safety and wellbeing of the children is our highest priority. We will continue to monitor conditions closely and ensure that children stay hydrated and cool throughout the day.

We kindly ask that children continue to bring a water bottle, sun cream, and a sun hat into school. Children may also wear their PE kits throughout the week if this helps them to remain cooler.
