English / Geography

Science / Forest School

Make a winter ice bauble. Find some natural items e.g. berries, leaves, twigs. Place them in the bottom of a plastic pot. Drape a piece of string across the items to make a loop. Cover the bottom of the pot with a small amount of water. Leave it outside when frost is forecast. Then, in the morning, hang it up outside. You should be able to pull the bauble out using the string.
